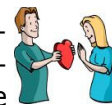

- 👂 Make verbal responses such as, "I see", "Really", "Uh Huh", to show you're paying attention
- 👂 Turn off the TV
- 👂 Put down the dishcloth, book, hairbrush, etc.
- 👂 Encourage them to tell you more
- 👂 Let the telephone ring if they are in the middle of telling you something
- 👂 Don't ask them to hurry
- 👂 Don't act bored
